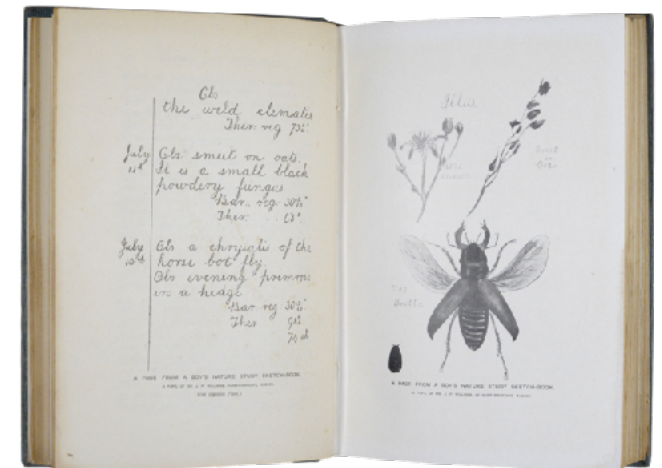
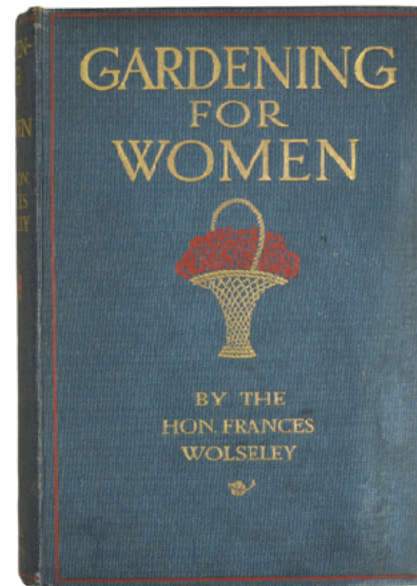
Jekyll, Gertrude. **Wall And Water Gardens.**

 colors and texture, she was a proponent of a wholly
 integrated house and garden. This book (her fourth overall
 and second for Country Life) looks closely at two elements
 of hardscape and examines how to construct and plant
 them. \$150.00*

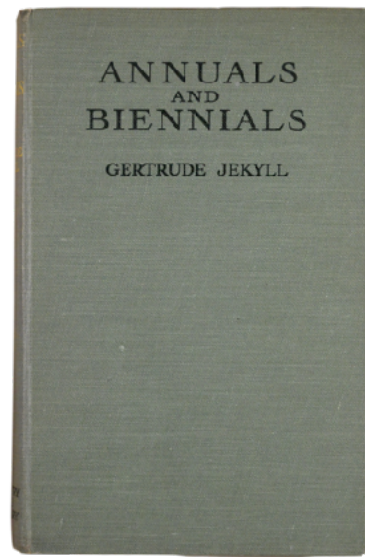

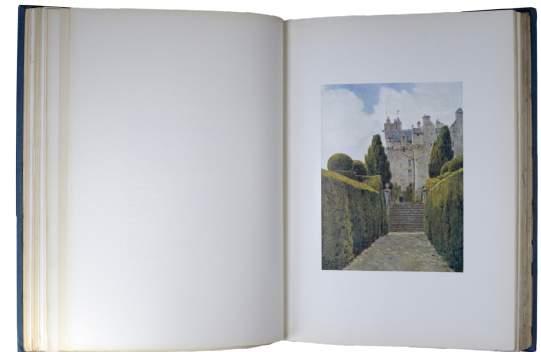
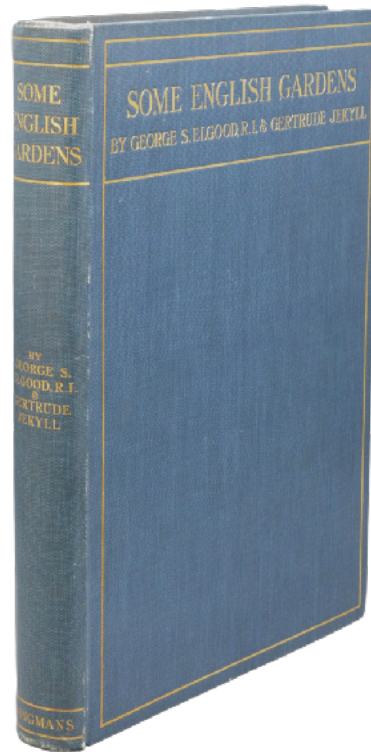
*Viscountess Wolseley was an early and major advocate of
